End of the 1984 Regular Season

Detroit's amazing Tigers ran away with the American League East title during a torrid hot streak that began with opening day - and no one ever got close. For the second half of the season, the Tigers were so far in front of the pack that they had to do little more than play breakeven baseball. In the West, it was a case of a title that was too elusive. Kansas City backed in when the Twins declined in the final weeks. The National League East was a delight to behold - Chicago finally achieved the "highest plateau," but the Western kings, San Diego, did them in during the playoffs, coming back from a 0-2 deficit to win the finale. Chicago has never recovered from this devastating blow.

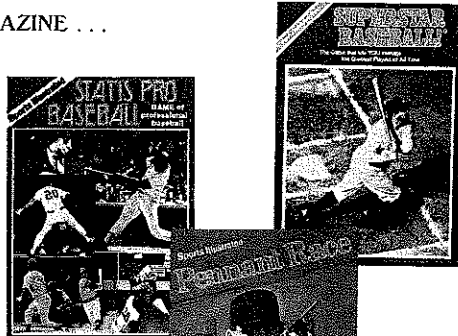
